Dixie County is a rural area, but holds ownership to many nature activities. Dixie County is bordered by the Steinhatchee River, Suwannee River,

and the Gulf of Mexico, so the water opportunities are plentiful. There is great fishing, boating, kayaking, canoeing, scalloping, and cave diving, even artificial reefs. (Any of these locations are approximately 20 miles from the Airport).

Inland, there are countless biking, hiking, birding, horseback, and motor vehicle trails ready for you to explore. To name a few, there is the Nature Coast Greenway Trail (approximately 2,000 feet from the Airport), the CR 349 Lower Suwannee National Wildlife Refuge Tour, as well as the mainlines which connect the coastal communities.
